The Best Western Hotel Porto Antico is located in Genova in Via al Ponte Calvi 5.

The hotel staff has been trained and is aware of the characteristics of people with autism spectrum disorders, of their special needs, and knows how to make the hotel fully inclusive.

Check-In and Check-Out

The lobby of the **Best Western Hotel Porto Antico** has a reception desk with a wooden desk and a red back wall, an internet point with a wooden desk and a red wall where the monitors are placed, luggage storage, a lift, two red sofas and red and pink armchairs in eco-leather, white walls. The decorative element (see picture) is an old iron signal beacon.

The hall is 70 square meters and there could be moments of great turnout with a consequent increase in waiting times and possible crowding with sensory overload.

The busiest times:

1.from 08:30 am to 12:30 am

2.from 05:00 pm to 08:00 pm

It is therefore advisable to check-in and check-out outside these hours.






Common areas

Rooms

The rooms dedicated to clients with ASD are equipped with features that can help in the case of atypical sensory reactivity:

- there are no neon lights but soft lighting
- the room is located far from noise sources
- cleaning products are fragrance free
- · air fresheners are not used

The **bedding** is white, and a duvet is available to guests. For specific needs, guests are allowed to bring with them their own **personal items** (**blankets** or **cushions**) and the staff will make the bed.

It is not possible to lock the windows, and the bathroom door can be closed only from the inside. There are blackout curtains. All rooms have minibar, kettle, TV and a fulllength mirror. All bathrooms have a shower with fixed head.

Breakfast

The breakfast room is located on the ground floor.

A table will be reserved for you in an area of the restaurant free from anything that could induce sensory processing disorder, away from busy passageways.

Breakfast is served in three timeslots:

• 07:00-07:50

• 08:00-08:50

• 09:00-10:00

The time of increased client influx, that may lead to a higher risk of sensory overload is in the third time slot and sometimes also in the second one.

Background music is played at a low volume. Guests can bring their **own food and drink** at the table.





Hotel Information
