### General Information

The Best Western Plus Hotel Le Rondini is located in San Francesco al Campo, near Turin, in Via Parrocchia 5/B.

The hotel staff has been trained and is aware of the characteristics of people with autism spectrum disorders, their needs and how the hotel must be organized to make it fully inclusive.

### Check-In & Check-Out

The lobby of the **Best Western Plus Hotel Le Rondini** is located on the first floor and has a width of 20 square meters (you can reach the entrance by car). It has an area equipped with seats and a flavored water dispenser (detox). The common services are located on the ground floor, easily accessible by elevator at the entrance of the hotel, next to the reception.

There could be moments of great turnout with a consequent increase in waiting times and possible sensory overload.

The most crowded times are:

- 1. from 8 to 10 am
- 2. from 5 pm to 8 pm

It is therefore advisable to check-in and check-out outside these hours.

The hotel is located near the airport (10min - 7km).

#### The rooms

The rooms dedicated to customers with ASD have some features that can **help** in case of **abnormal sensory reactivity**:

- 1. Non-neon and soft lights
- 2. Room away from noise sources
- 3. Use of cleaning detergents with neutral fragrance
- 4. No air fresheners

The **bed linen** is white. The duvet is available to guests. If the guest has special needs, he or she can bring a **personal blanket or pillow**, and the staff will arrange the bed.

The windows can be opened either completely or with vasistas and overlook the external courtyard. Blackout curtains are present.

There is a minibar that contains water, beer, fruit juices, soft drinks, sweet and savory snacks.

On the table there is an electric kettle. In each room there is television, air conditioning and mirror. In some rooms there are paintings with photographs of indoor premises.

All bathrooms are equipped with showers, there is no bathtub. Not all rooms have a windowed bathroom, in this case there is a fan.

Room service can be requested at number 9.

## Outer space

The outdoor area of the **Best Western Plus Hotel Le Rondini** is accessible directly from the bar and the breakfast room. The area is equipped with tables and seats and can be used to relax, have breakfast or have a drink during the day.

The hotel is located near Turin Airport (Caselle), so you might hear the passing planes.

The area is surrounded by plants, in particular there is the presence of jasmine, which can release an intense scent in spring and summer.

The soil is partly made up of gravel and partly of stone slabs. There are tables with chairs, where you can have breakfast, have a drink from the bar and relax.
